

ORDINANCE #30, 2008

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 152 OF THE CITY CODE ENTITLED "SIGN REGULATIONS" IN ITS ENTIRETY

WHEREAS, Article IX of the City of Valparaiso Zoning Ordinance sets forth a comprehensive set of regulations governing the placement of signs within the City limits; and

WHEREAS, prior to the adoption of Article XI of the City of Valparaiso Zoning Ordinance, the regulations governing signage were set forth in Chapter 152 of the City of Valparaiso Code of Ordinances;

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the City that certain sections of Chapter 152 of the Valparaiso Code of Ordinances may still be in effect; and

WHEREAS, in order to eliminate confusion as to the applicable sign regulations, the City of Valparaiso desires to formally repeal Chapter 152 of the Valparaiso Code of Ordinances in its entirety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Valparaiso, Porter County, Indiana as follows:

- 1. That Chapter 152 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Valparaiso is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 1. If any portion of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect any other portion or provision of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency. It is provided, however, that such repeal shall be only to the extent of such inconsistency, and in all other respects the ordinance or parts of ordinances are hereby ratified, re-established and confirmed.
